


44th AVENUE EAST EXTENSION PROJECT FROM 45th STREET EAST TO WEST OF I-75

Manatee County | Public Works

Construction Start: May 2020 | Anticipated Completion: Fall 2022 | Project Cost: \$54.6 Million



Project Information

This project continues the extension of 44th Avenue East and is the fifth in a series of Manatee County projects that will ultimately connect 44th Avenue East from US 41 to Lakewood Ranch Boulevard. This project consists of approximately 3.27 miles of roadway improvements starting at 45th Street East, continuing east across the Braden River, and ending approximately a quarter mile west of the I-75 right-of-way. In addition to a new bridge being constructed across the Braden River, the project includes the widening of 44th Avenue East from two to four-lanes, multi-use trails, sidewalks, and lighting within the 44th Avenue East right-of-way.

Caruso Road and Morgan Johnson Road will be realigned to create a two-lane signalized intersection at 44th Avenue East. The intersection of 44th Avenue East and Creekwood Boulevard will also be signalized. The realigned sections of Caruso Road and Morgan Johnson Road will be constructed to accommodate a future four-lane intersection.

Project Benefits

- Widening of 44th Avenue East to a four-lane road with designated bike lanes and multi-use trail
- Improved utilities, stormwater management facilities and drainage infrastructure
- Construction of a four-lane bridge over the Braden River including sidewalks and a multi-use trail
- Addition of signalized intersections
- Street lighting
