

## PROJECT UPDATE | JUNE 3, 2024



### Project 5 (from 45th Street East to West of I-75)

Permanent striping of the roadway is now complete. Remaining activities include the installation of signage and signalization. The intersection of 44th Avenue East and Creekwood Boulevard will continue to operate as a three-way stop until the installation of the signal equipment is complete and inspected.

### Project 6 (from I-75 to Lakewood Ranch Boulevard)

**I-75 Median:** Bridge foundation and column work are complete. Crews will be working on constructing the pier cap throughout the month of June 2024. Closures of the inside northbound and southbound travel lanes of I-75 will be in effect within the work zone to accommodate this activity.

**West of I-75:** The contractor continues construction of the retaining wall in the area west of I-75, just north of The Ridge at Crossing Creek community, in preparation for the bridge over I-75.

**East of I-75:** Pile-driving operations in the County's reclaimed water storage lake, directly south of the Manatee County Wastewater Plant, is ongoing and will be followed by the construction of bridge pile caps. Other activities include the construction of an embankment and the retaining wall for the eastern end of the bridge over I-75, as well as storm drainage and utilities.

Construction activities are being conducted **Monday through Friday, between the hours of 7 a.m. and 6 p.m.**, with nighttime work to occur on an as-needed basis. Residents are asked to be mindful of construction equipment and materials being operated and staged in right of way areas.
