

PROJECT UPDATE | JUNE 24, 2024



Project 5 (from 45th Street East to West of I-75)

The installation of signage and signalization is now complete, and the traffic signals have been activated within the project area on 44th Avenue East. In late summer 2024, the contractor will begin installation of a dedicated right turn lane on eastbound 44th Avenue East at 45th Street East. This project is substantially complete.

Project 6 (from I-75 to Lakewood Ranch Boulevard)

I-75 Median: Bridge work will be ongoing throughout the month of June 2024. Nighttime closures of the inside northbound and southbound travel lanes of I-75 will be in effect to accommodate this activity.

West of I-75: The contractor continues construction of the retaining wall in the area west of I-75, just north of The Ridge at Crossing Creek community, in preparation for the bridge over I-75.

East of I-75: Bridge pile work in the County's reclaimed water storage lake, directly south of the Manatee County Wastewater Plant, is ongoing. Concrete substructure work on the South Lake bridge has begun and will continue through the end of the year. Other activities in this area will include the construction of an embankment and the retaining wall for the eastern end of the bridge over I-75, as well as storm drainage and utilities.

Construction activities are being conducted **Monday through Friday, between the hours of 7 a.m. and 6 p.m.**, with nighttime work to occur on an as-needed basis. Residents are asked to remain observant of construction vehicles, materials, and equipment while traveling within the construction areas.
